
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What tools and materials do you need?


- 1 base of Styrodur (hard foam) approx. 30 cm x 30 cm and at least 3 cm thick.
- 1 very fine prickle tool, Ø 0,7 mm (also available in my shop)
- 4 glass head needle, 30 x 0,60 mm
- 1 fine sewing needle, 32 x Ø 0,5 mm
- 1 scissors
- Polyester yarn no. 40 in the colours: pink, violet, lavender, green multicolour and yellow
- Metallic yarn No. 40 in the colour: gold
- white cardboard 300 g/m², size min. 13,5 x 13,5 cm






Print out the present hole pattern.




Cut out the hole pattern.




Place the hole pattern centrally over thephoto cardboard on the hard foam plate.



Fix the hole pattern with the glass headpins in the black dots.




Transfer the holes with a fine fine prickle tool needle.




Then pull the thread with needle andthread (in the pattern "pink").

The starting node must always be on theback!



Start with the petals Level I in the color of your choice (in the pattern "pink")


Hole 22 out \rightarrow hole 1 in \rightarrow 21 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 20 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 19 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 18 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 17 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 16 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 15 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 14 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 13 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 12 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 11 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 10 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 9 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 8 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 7 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 6 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 5 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 4 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 3 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 2 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow Repeat the petals Level I another 7 times.




Knot the new thread (in the pattern violet) for the petals level II!

Please do not use tape to attach thethreads!

This dries out over time and separates from the cardboard. The tension of the threads is lost or the whole graphic becomes unsightly.



Continue with the **petals Level II** in a colour of your choice: (in the sample in the colours "violet") Hole 11 out \rightarrow hole 12 in \rightarrow 10 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 9 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 8 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 7 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 6 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 5 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 4 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 3 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 2 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 10 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 20 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 19 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 18 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 17 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 16 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 15 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 14 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 13 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow Repeat the **petals Level II** another 7 times.




Knot the new thread (in the pattern lavender) for the bloom !!









Continue with the **bloom I** in a colour of your choice: (in the sample in the colours "lavender") Hole 12 out \rightarrow hole 1 in \rightarrow 11 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 10 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 9 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 8 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 7 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 6 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 5 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 4 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 3 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow 2 out \rightarrow 1 in \rightarrow Repeat the **bloom I** another 7 times.




Knot the new thread (in the pattern green multicolor) for the bloom II!



Continue with the bloom II in a colour of your choice: (in the sample in the colours "green multicolor") Hole 7 out \rightarrow hole 1 in \rightarrow 2 out \rightarrow 6 in \rightarrow 5 out \rightarrow 3 in \rightarrow 4 out \rightarrow 4 in \rightarrow 3 out \rightarrow 5 in \rightarrow 6 out \rightarrow 2 in \rightarrow 1 out \rightarrow 7 in \rightarrow 8 out \rightarrow 2 in \rightarrow 3 out \rightarrow 9 in \rightarrow 10 out \rightarrow 4 in \rightarrow 5 out \rightarrow 11 in \rightarrow 12 out \rightarrow 6 in \rightarrow 7 out \rightarrow 13 in \rightarrow 14 out \rightarrow 8 in \rightarrow 9 out \rightarrow 15 in \rightarrow 12 out \rightarrow 10 in \rightarrow 11 out \rightarrow 11 in \rightarrow 10 out \rightarrow 12 in \rightarrow 13 out \rightarrow 9 in \rightarrow 8 out \rightarrow 14 in \rightarrow 15 out \rightarrow 7 in \rightarrow



Knot the new thread (in the pattern yellow) for the bloom centre Level I!

Knot the new thread (in the patternmetallic yarn gold) for the bloom centre Level II!




Continue with the **bloom centre level II** in a colour of your choice: (in the sample in the colours metallic yarn "gold")

Hole 1 out \Rightarrow hole 5 in \Rightarrow 6 out \Rightarrow 2 in \Rightarrow 3 out \Rightarrow 7 in \Rightarrow 8 out \Rightarrow 4 in \Rightarrow 5 out \Rightarrow 9 in \Rightarrow 10 out \Rightarrow 6 in \Rightarrow 7 out \Rightarrow 11 in \Rightarrow 12 out \Rightarrow 8 in \Rightarrow 9 out \Rightarrow 13 in \Rightarrow 14 out \Rightarrow 10 in \Rightarrow 11 out \Rightarrow 15 in \Rightarrow 16 out \Rightarrow 12 in \Rightarrow 13 out \Rightarrow 1 in \Rightarrow 2 out \Rightarrow 14 in \Rightarrow 15 out \Rightarrow 3 in \Rightarrow 4 out \Rightarrow 16 in \Rightarrow 1 out \Rightarrow 7 in \Rightarrow 9 out \Rightarrow 6 in \Rightarrow 1 out \Rightarrow 11 in \Rightarrow 13 out \Rightarrow 36 in \Rightarrow 31 out \Rightarrow 15 in. \Rightarrow Finished!
